City Tech to Host Two 'Brooklyn Tech Triangle Tech U' Panel Discussions on April 24

Brooklyn, NY – April 2, 2014 – New York City College of Technology (City Tech) in Downtown Brooklyn will host two panel discussions on Thursday, April 24 as part of a week-long series of events sponsored by Brooklyn Tech Triangle to connect local tech/creative firms with the area's 50,000-plus college students. The events are free and open to the public.

The first discussion, "Advanced Technologies for Design & Construction," will be held at 11:00 a.m. in the college's Voorhees Hall 2nd Floor Lounge, 186 Jay Street (north of Tillary), and will look at the next wave of technology for sustainable design and construction. The second discussion, "Startup 101," will be held at 5:30 p.m. in Namm Hall 119, 300 Jay Street (at Tillary), and will examine what potential candidates should know about working in the entrepreneurial world.
