Please complete the steps below:

Make sure City Tech has received an *official transcript from all previously attended colleges and/o
post-secondary institutions.

Official transcript(s) must:

- contain official seal
- include final semester grades
- provide graduation date, if applicable **
- * Electronic records must be sent directly from attended colleges and/or post-secondary institutions.
- ** If unable to provide an official transcript with graduation date, a sealed letter from the Registrar will be sufficient.
- Claim Account: If you have not claimed your CUNYfirst account, go to home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu to do so. If you have any questions, email the Student Help Desk at studenthelpdesk@citytech.cuny.edu or call (718) 260-4900.
- Accept your offer: Accept your offer of admission from City Tech by going to your CUNYfirst account at home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu.
- Students who have graduated from a foreign high school are required to take the Ability to Benefit (ATB) test before **September 14**, **2024**. Once you have registered for classes you should contact the Office of Academic Testing at testingoffice@citytech.cuny.edu to schedule an appointment.

	Proof of immunization and vaccine verification is not needed for remote learning, but it is required for in-person and hybrid courses. Submit your immunization proof to the Student Document Repository. If you don't have proof, our immunization form can be downloaded. Upload your proof or completed forms to the Student Document Repository .
