SPONSOR SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

A sponsor must show sufficient income and/or financial resources to assure that the student being sponsored will not become a public charge (receive Federal or State low-income benefits or services) while in the United States.

Evidence should consist of copies of the following documentation listed below that apply to the sponsor's situation. Failure to provide proof of sufficient income and/or financial resources may result in the denial of the student's application for a visa or their removal from the United States.

The sponsor must submit evidence of income and resources, as appropriate:

- A. Written statement from an officer of the bank or other financial institution or brokerage where the sponsor has accounts, giving the following details regarding the account:
 - 1. Date account opened
 - 2. Total amount deposited for the past year
 - 3. Present balance
- B. Statement of your employer on business stationery showing:
 - 1. Date and nature of employment
 - 2. Salary paid
 - 3. Whether the position is temporary or permanent
- C. If self-employed:
 - 1. Copy of last income tax return filed or
 - 2. Report of commercial rating concern
 - 3. Schedule of assets with supporting documents
