

FERPA RELEASE FORM Permission for Access to Education Records

Students who wish to grant third parties, including parents, access to education records maintained by New York City College of Technology should use this form, which requires a date and signature. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 ("FERPA" or the "Act") is a federal law that establishes the privacy rights of students with regard to their education records. The Act prohibits access to, or the release of, education records or personally identifiable information contained in such records without the written consent of the student.
