### STEP 1: Speech Screenings (virtual)\*

The Departments of Humanities (NYCCT) and Communication Arts, Sciences, and Disorders (Brooklyn College) are offering complimentary, online speech screenings for City Tech students, faculty and staff. In individual, private consultation and under the supervision of NYS licensed clinical faculty, graduate students in Speech Language Pathology will assess speech and share their findings, noting any aspects that may be interfering with clear, effective English language communication. These may include:

- accents and regionalisms
- unclear articulation
- speech pathologies and communication disorders

Individual speech screenings are available every half hour, at the following dates and times:
