

The Social Science Department at City Tech announces its new

History Minor

The History minor provides students with the opportunity to study history more intensively than would otherwise be permitted, and facilitates the mastery of skills in analysis, research, writing and critical thinking. Upon completion of the requirements, students can graduate with an official "History minor" noted on their academic transcripts starting in the Fall semester 2024.

The History minor requires 15 credits of coursework: 5 courses from the following menu of three credit courses in History, African-American or Latin American studies. At least 4 of the 5 courses must be designated as HIS and a minimum of 1 of these courses must be an HIS 3000 level course requiring a research paper. These courses fulfill multiple General Education and Pathways requirements, and they can also fulfill requirements for Interdisciplinary (ID) Study, Writing Intensive (WI) or Capstone courses. All courses must be completed with a grade of C or better.
