POLICY ON NON-COMPLIANCE OF JRCERT STANDARDS

Radiography students, faculty, graduates, or other individuals have the right to file a complaint with the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) concerning any failure by the Department to comply with the STANDARDS of the JRCERT and undermines their educational pursuit at New York City College of Technology.

The policy's purpose is to address non-compliance with the JRCERT STANDARDS.

This policy particularly applies in cases where an individual has a complaint about the Department non-compliance. Please be advised that students, faculty, graduates, or other individuals are not required to inform the Department, or New York City College of Technology, of the decision to report allegations to the JRCERT. Also, JRCERT will not reveal the student, faculty, graduates, or other individuals' information or identity unless it is required to do so through the legal process.
