Please complete the steps below:

- ◆ Claim Account: If you have not claimed your CUNYfirst account, go to home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu to do so. If you have any questions, email the Student Help Desk at studenthelpdesk@citytech.cuny.edu or call (718) 260 4900.
- If you are a **June 2024** graduate, submit proof of high school completion to the Student Document Repository before **August 28, 2024**. Please <u>click here</u> for further instructions.
- ◆ Students who have graduated from a foreign high school are required to take the Ability to Benefit (ATB) test before **September 14, 2024**. Once you have registered for classes you should contact the Office of Academic Testing at testingoffice@citytech.cuny.edu to schedule an appointment.

International Students

If you identify as an international F1 visa seeking student please visit the Office of International Students Services (OISS) web-page. F1s transferring within the US are required to complete the City Tech Transfer Form and an L=20 Request Form. Click here for instructions on how to obtain a Visa.

Immunization

Submit your immunization proof to the Student Document Repository. If you don't have proof, our immunization form can be downloaded here. Upload your proof or the completed forms to the Student Document Repository. Please click here for further instructions.

Residency

If requested, submit the paperwork necessary to receive in-state tuition to the Student Document Repository. <u>Click here</u> for further instructions.
