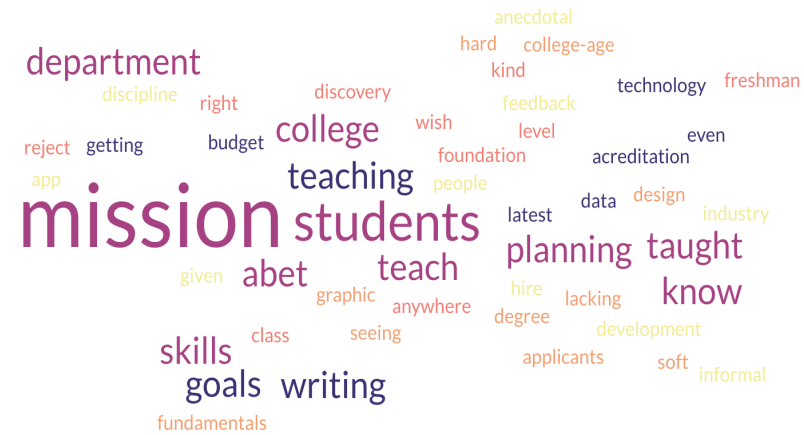

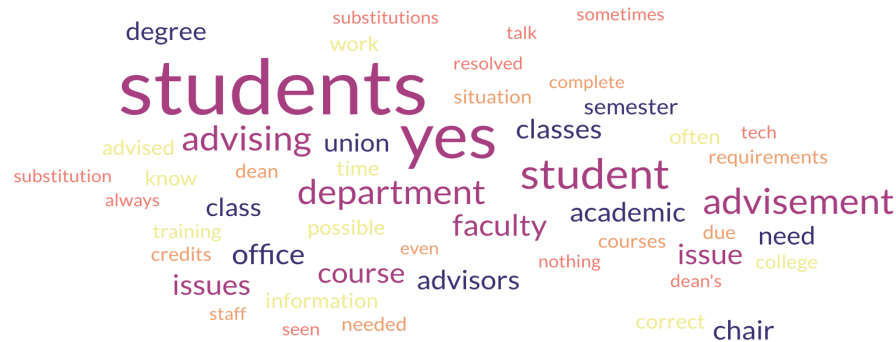

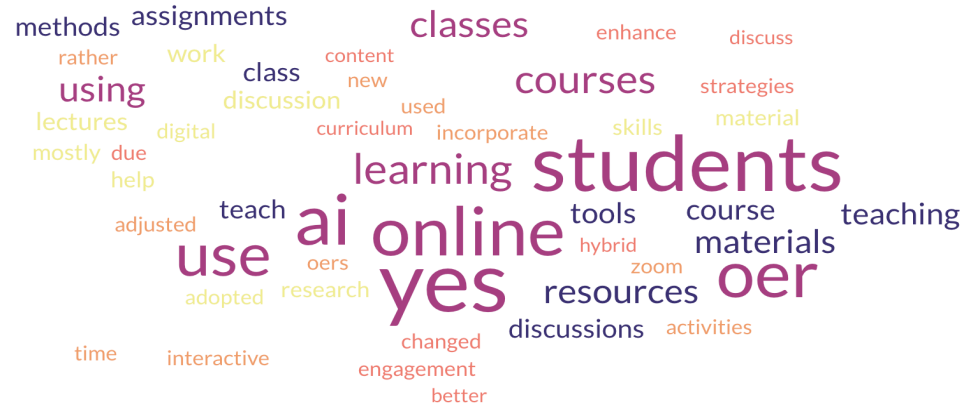
9. Have any of your students encountered issues due to incorrect or misleading academic advising? If so, how was the situation resolved, and what actions, if any, were taken to address it?

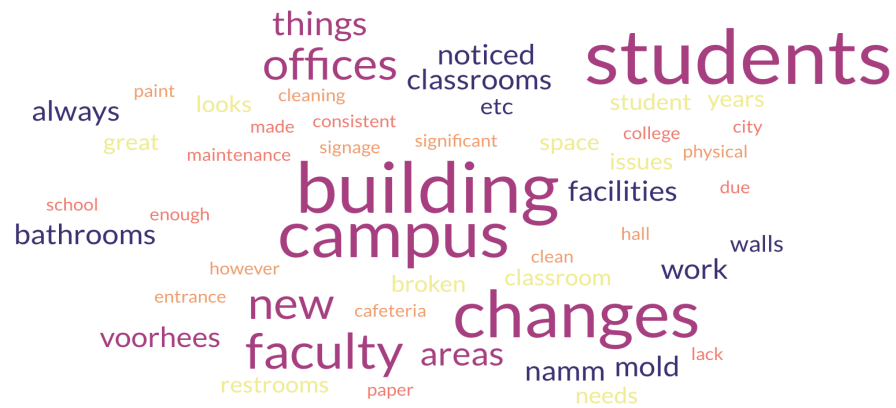

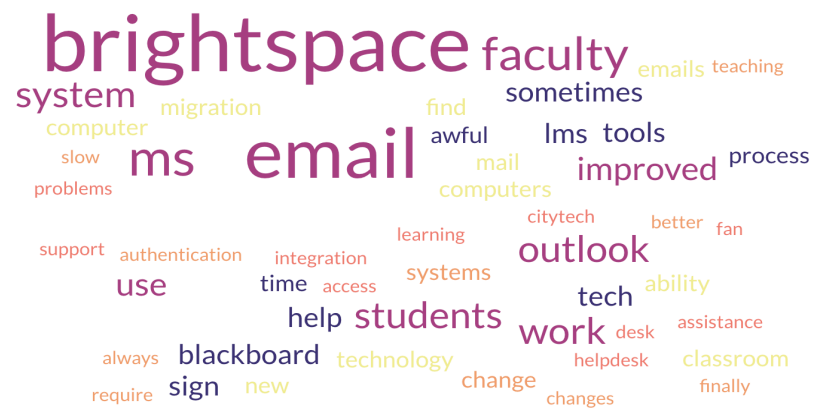

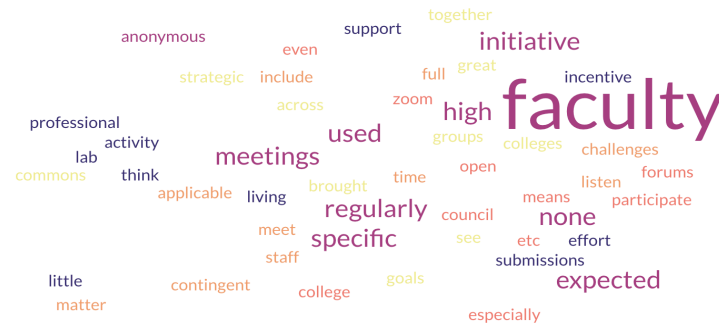

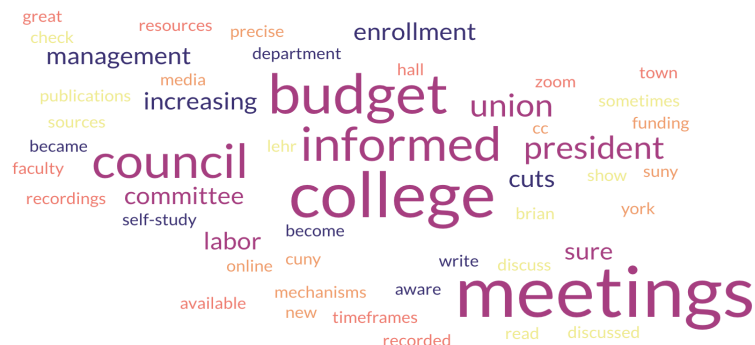
