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Introduction

Report time: **academic year 2021-2022 (Fall 2021, Spring 2022)**

Three-level academic assessment:

- General Education Assessment (college-level)
 - Assessed on pre-planned college wide schedule
 - three-year cycle on 14 competencies/student outcomes
- Program Assessment (program-level)
 - All degree programs (associate + bachelor's)
 - Assessed on departmental schedule, 3-year cycle maximum (recommended)
- Critical Course Assessment (course-level)
 - At least one course per department
 - Assessed on departmental schedule, 2-year cycle maximum (recommended)

Assessment activities:

- Gen Ed assessment on five competencies: data collection in Fall 2021 and AEI (Analysis of data, evaluation of report, drafting of improvement plan) submission in Spring 2022:
 - Information Literacy
 - Civic Engagement
 - Critical Thinking
 - Ethical Reasoning
 - Teamwork
- Submit critical course assessment annual updates in Fall 2021
- Submit program-level assessment annual updates in Spring 2022

Assessment system updates:

- AIRE office continued to further streamline the academic assessment system.
- A similar online form as program assessment was developed to facilitate critical course assessment management, the “Critical Course Assessment Annual Updates” online form. The form has been in use since Fall 2021.

Highlights

- In sum, 36 courses were assigned for Gen Ed assessment data collection in Fall 2021, 25 courses submitted data on time, and 12 courses further submitted AEI (Analysis of data, evaluation of report, drafting of improvement plan) based on their assessment results in the following Spring 2022. Accordingly, the data submission rate was 69.4%, and AEI submission rate was 48.0% college wide.
- In total, 1,063 students from 25 courses college-wide have been evaluated on five Gen Ed competencies in Fall 2020.
 - Information Literacy (6 courses, 300 students)
 - Civic Engagement (3 courses, 60 students)
 - Critical Thinking (6 courses, 370 students)
 - Ethical Reasoning (6 courses, 185 students)
 - Teamwork (4 courses, 148 students)
- Areas did not meet faculty criteria college-wide (recommended target percentage of students who met or exceeded faculty criteria is 70%):
 - Information Literacy: Identify credible and relevant sources (69.3%)
 - Civic Engagement: Civic Action and Reflection (51.6%), Civic Communication (67.7%), Civic Identity and Commitment (35.5%)
 - Critical Thinking: Conclusions and related outcomes (63.9%), Evidence (66.9%), Influence of context and assumptions (65.7%)
 - Ethical Reasoning: Application of Ethical Perspectives/Concepts (66.0%)
 - Teamwork: Contributes to Team Meetings (59.7%), Facilitates the Contributions of Team Members (60.5%), Fosters Constructive Team Climate (63.6%), Responds to Conflict (66.7%)
- Regarding program assessment, 22.0% (13 out of the 59 active degree programs) have submitted their assessment status via AIRE's online program assessment annual update form in Spring 2022. Additionally, one completed report received.
- Regarding critical course assessment, there are 46 active and 15 inactive critical courses across 28 departments. In sum, 18 out of the 46 active courses (39.1%) have submitted their assessment status via AIRE's online critical course assessment annual update form in Fall 2021. Additionally, 8 reports received (4 completed, 4 partial/other).

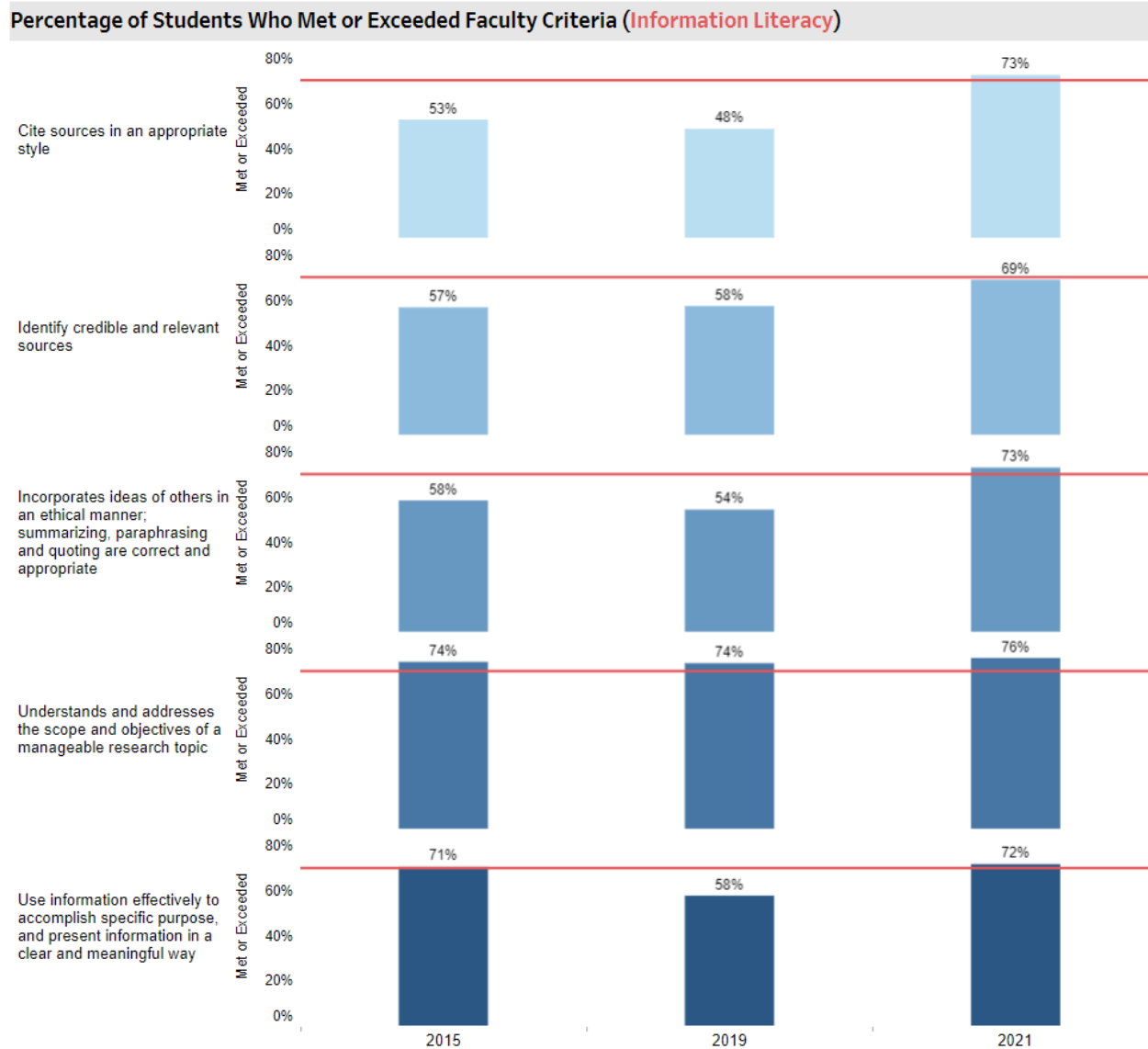

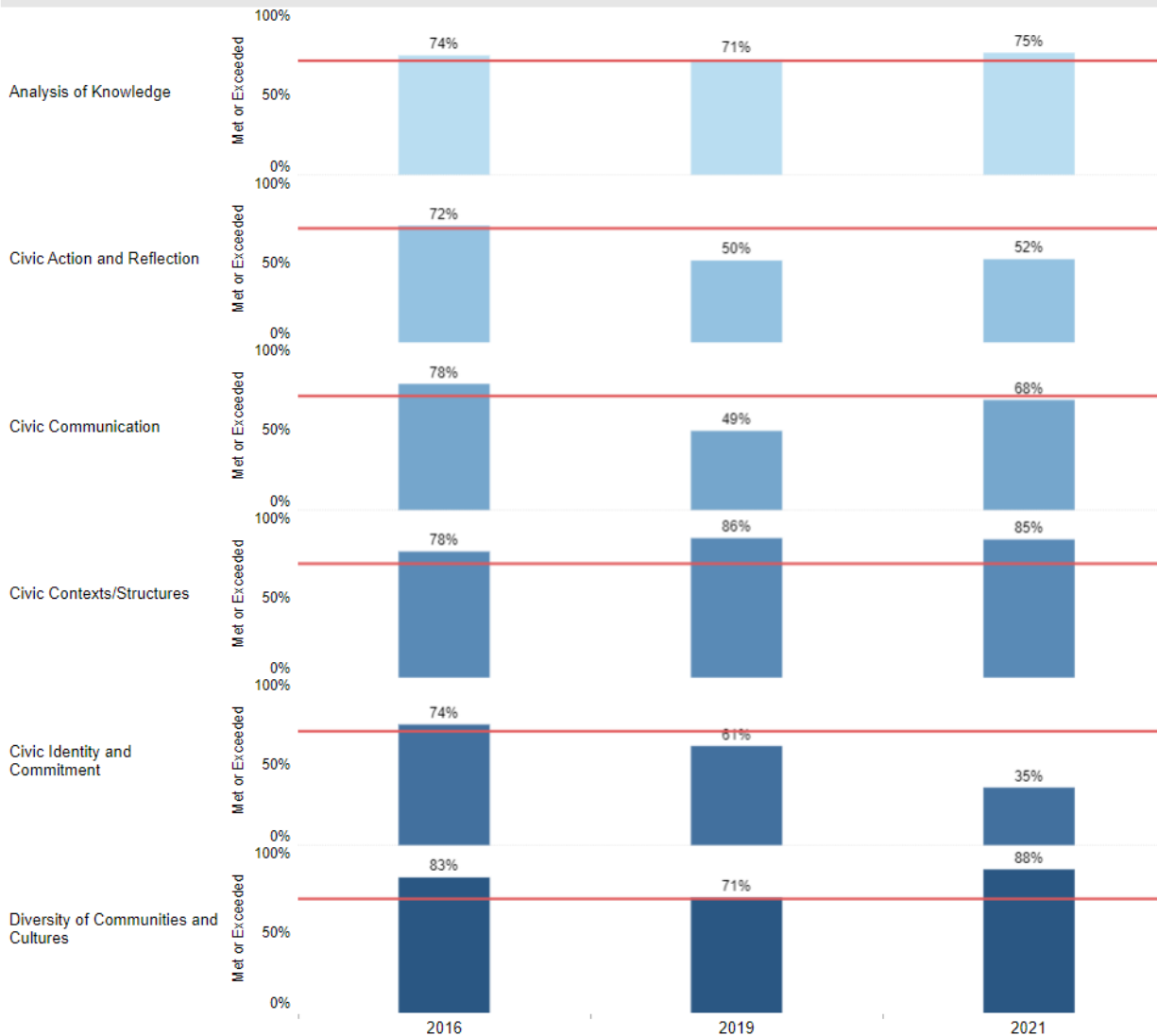

Percentage of Students Who Met or Exceeded Faculty Criteria (Civic Engagement)

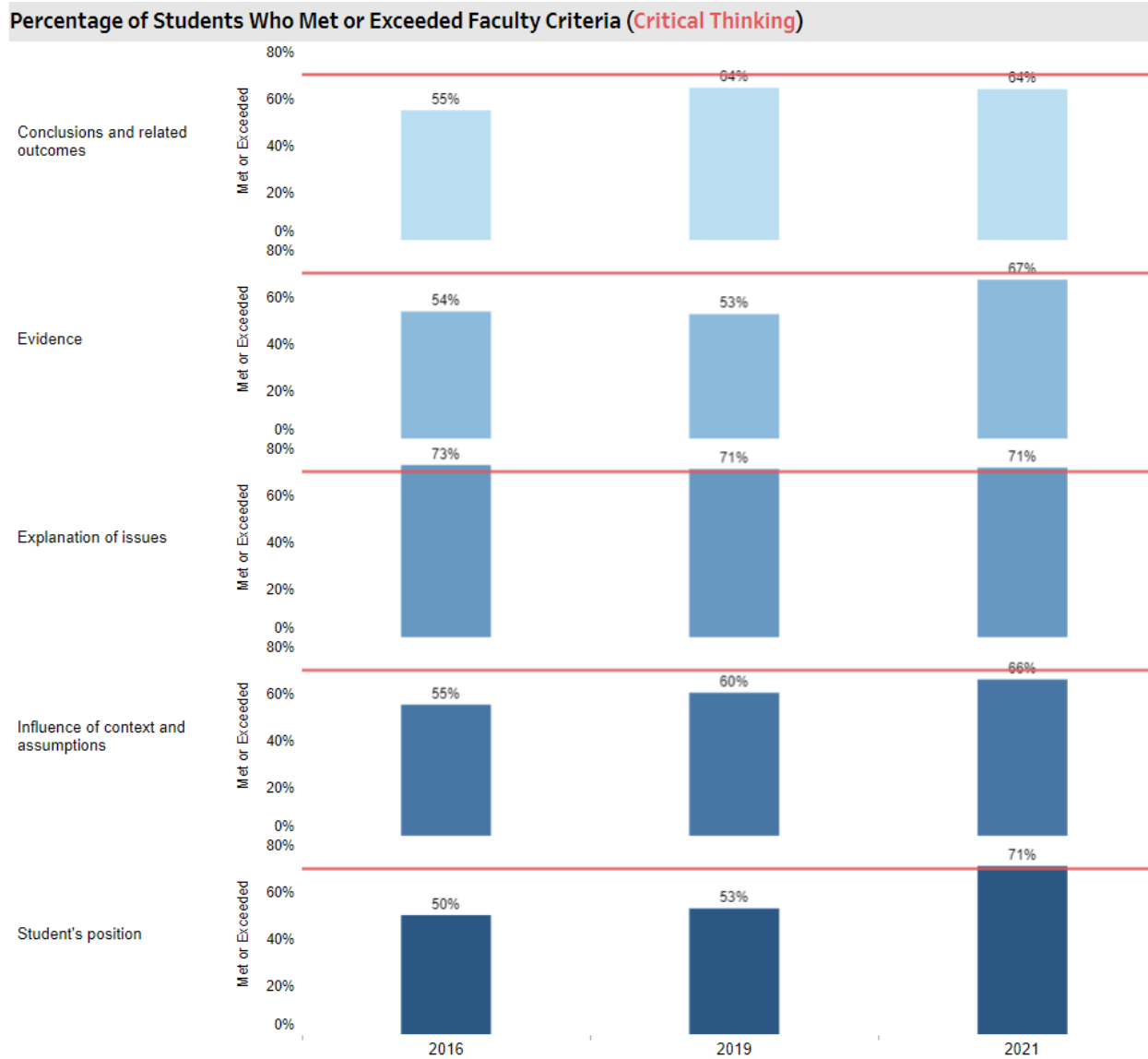

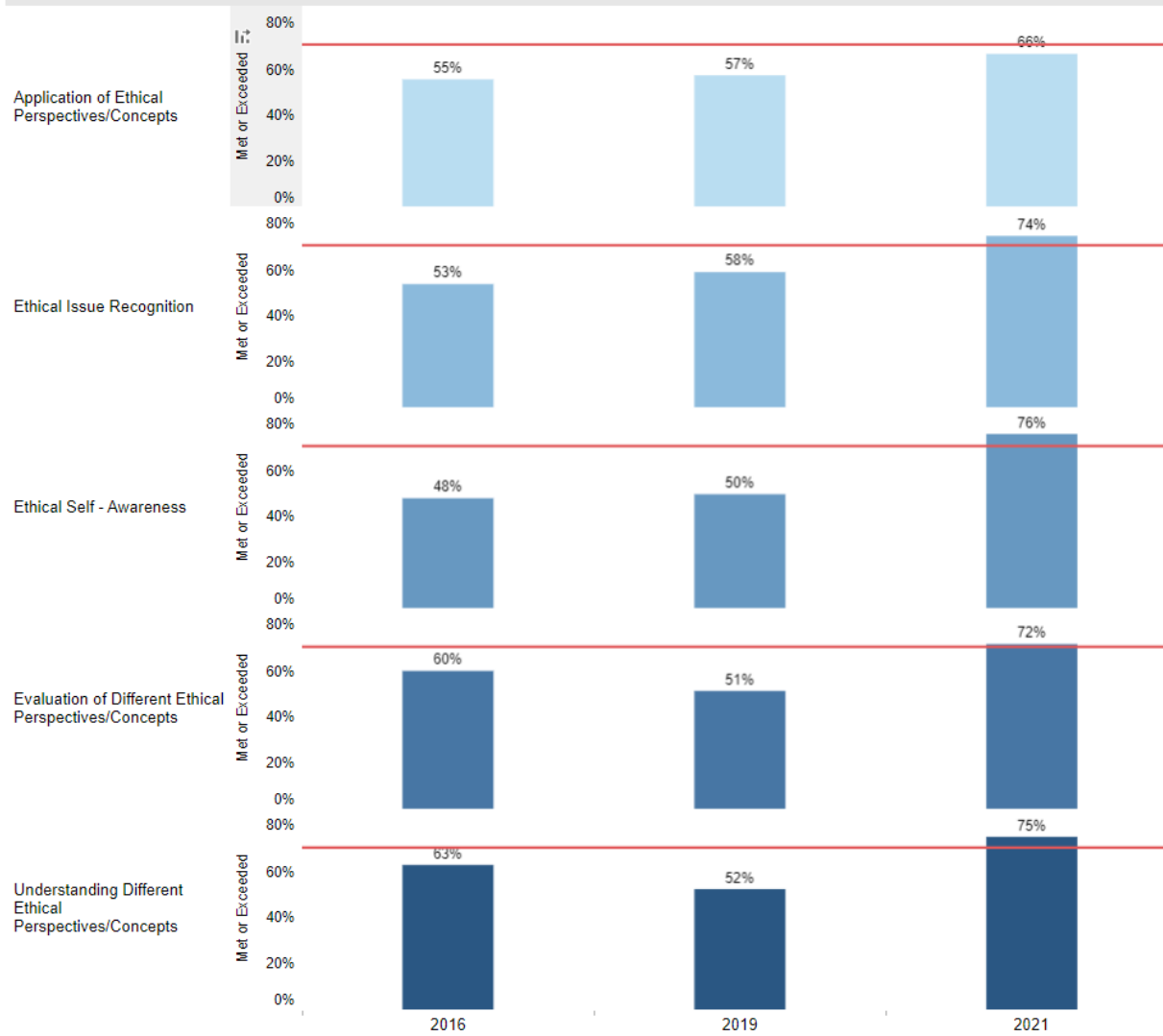

Percentage of Students Who Met or Exceeded Faculty Criteria (Ethical Reasoning)

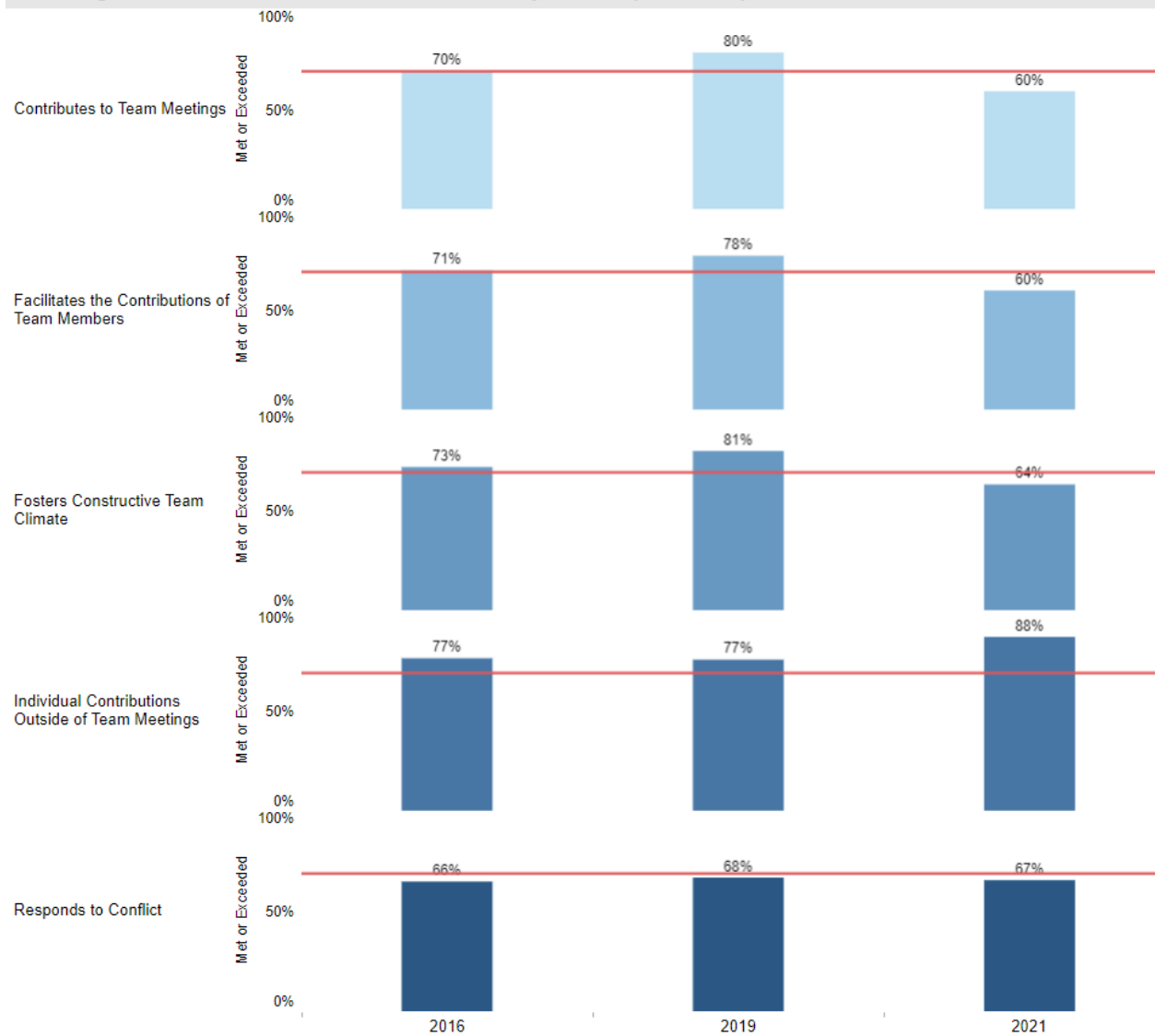
