



You can connect to the campus wireless network utilizing a wireless capable device such as a laptop.

## <u>Note:</u> Before attempting to connect to the secure network (**NYCCT**), make sure that you have the latest antivirus data definitions and operating system patches.

You can download the McAfee Antivirus software for free from the CUNY E-mall. Please speak with the Student Helpdesk for more instructions.





1. Click on <u>Wireless Network Connections</u> on the taskbar (bottom right).

2. Select the "NYCCT" network and click on "Connect".

The first letter of every word **MUST** be capitalized. The Security Key is case sensitive.

After entering the Security Key, click on "OK".

7. The FortiNAC Dissolvable Agent will scan your laptop to make sure you have an updated antivirus program. This may take a few minutes.



8. After the scan, a message will appear telling you that the Dissolvable agent has finished connecting your PC to the network.

Click on Finish.

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9. The web browser will automatically appear. Wait until the progress bar loads. After it completes, the City Tech main webpage will appear.
