

FOR ON-THE-SPOT ADMISSION

1. Application Fee

A \$65.00 application fee must be paid online using a Visa/MasterCard credit card or debit card. You can also pay with an electronic check (E-check). In order to use an electronic check you must have both your bank routing number and checking account number. All application fee payments need to be paid using the CUNYfirst admission application.

2. Associate Degree Programs

High school diploma with minimum of a 70 average or a minimum score of 2700 on the GED/HSE exam.

3. Bachelor's Degree Programs

High school diploma with a 75 or higher average or a minimum score of 2700 on the GED/HSE exam.

Some high demand and select programs require an 80 or higher average and may have specific admission criteria.

Please contact us for additional information on the major to which you wish to apply.

4. All students must demonstrate proficiency in English and Math:

SAT: Verbal score 480 or Higher; Math score 530 or higher

ACT: English score 20 or Higher; Math score 21 or

NY State Regents:

- Common Core Regents: Score of 70 or higher in Algebra I OR a score of 70 or higher in Geometry OR a score of 65 or higher in Algebra 2."
- Score of 80 or higher in Integrated Algebra or Geometry OR Algebra 2/Trigonometry AND successful completion of the Algebra 2/Trigonometry or higher-level course.'
- Score of 75 or higher in one of the following: Math A or Math B Sequential II or Sequential III

Due to testing disruptions caused by the COVID-19 crisis, SAT and ACT test score will not be collected or used for admissions or proficiency determinations through the Spring 2023 admissions cycle. The University will continue to collect Regents exam scores to use for proficiency determinations. Proficiency index (PI) will be based on Regents exam scores (when available) and an applicant's high school GPA.
