The methods the college employs to advise and to update students about security procedures.

In addition to the Student Handbook, crime prevention pamphlets that include various safety tips and encourage the reporting of a crime on campus are prepared and distributed periodically to students. Speakers, including law enforcement officials, are invited by the administration and student groups to inform students about prevention of crime and personal safety. Additionally, Campus Public Safety meets with the College's Advisory Committee on Campus Security on a regular basis to exchange information on recent events and security concerns on campus. The Security Advisory Committee is made up of faculty, administrators, and student officers. This committee reviews current campus security policies and practices and makes recommendations for their improvement.
