

- You Can File a FAFSA and TAP Application for Summer and Fall 2023, now but that is not the application we are using for the spring Semester.
 - The college will be reviewing those applications in mid-spring for eligibility and to inform you of any issues with those applications.

FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM, FEDERAL PELL GRANT 1 OR MORE CREDITS/UNITS

- MAXIMUM OF 6 YEARS AT THE EQUIVALENT OF 12 SEMESTERS OF FULL -TIME PAYMENTS
- CHECK WWW.STUDENTAID.GOV FOR NUMBER OF AWARDS RECEIVED
- FEDERAL FSEOG (MINIMUM OF 6 CREDITS/UNITS) EACH SEMESTER
 INELIGIBLE IF RECEIVED MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PELL PAYMENTS
- FEDERAL WORK STUDY (MINIMUM OF 6 CREDITS/UNITS) EACH SEMESTER

LIMITED NUMBER OF PAYMENTS FOR NYS PROGRAMS

- 2 Year Degree Program:
 - Maximum of 6 semesters of TAP payments
- 4 Year Degree Program:
 - Maximum of 8 semesters of TAP payments
- SEEK Program:
 - Maximum of 6 semesters of TAP payments in a 2-year program and 10 semesters in a 4-year program

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID: MAJOR GRANT PROGRAMS

Sources and Types of Financial Aid: Major Grant Programs

PELL Grant

- Must have EFC between \$0 \$5,846
- 2022-23 maximum annual award \$6,495 and a minimum of \$672.00

NYS TAP Grant

- Based on NYS net taxable income
- Maximum annual award \$5,165

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID: FEDERAL WORK STUDY

Sources and Types of Financial Aid: Federal Work Study

- Based on financial need
- On- or off- campus employment
- Usually, 20 hours per week
- Must check "yes" that you are interested on the FAFSA



TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID: WILLIAM D. FORD DIRECT LOAN

Subsidized

- 4.99% Interest rate
- 1.057% Origination Fee
- Based on need
- Federal government pays interest while student is in school
- \$3,500 for freshmen

Unsubsidized

- 4.99% Interest rate
- 1.057% Origination Fee
- Not based on need
- Student is responsible for interest while in school
- Loan cannot exceed cost of education minus financial aid

Maximum Direct Loans for freshmen: \$5,500. This is a combination of \$3500 in the subsidized loan and \$2000 in the unsubsidized loan

TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID: WILLIAM D. FORD DIRECT LOA PARENT PLUS LOANS

For parents of dependent students

- Borrow up to entire cost of college less financial aid
- No adverse credit (parent must pass credit check)
- Interest rate 7.54%
- 4.228% Origination Fee

Payment Plans

May vary...typically, families spread the direct costs over the semester or year.

BORROW FROM FEDERAL DIRECT LOANS

• Dependent Undergraduates: Maximum \$31,000 (no more than \$23,000 may be subsidized)

• Independent Undergraduates: Maximum \$57,500 (no more than \$23,000 may be subsidized)

FOLLOW-UP LOAN APPLICATION RESULTS

- Minimum 6 credits/units each semester
- Limit on Subsidized Loan:
 - maximum 3 years for a 2-year Degree Program
 - maximum 6 years for a 4-year Degree Program
- Loans based on cumulative credits Year in College and Dependency Status (Independent or Dependent)
- Add City Tech to the Entrance Counseling at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>
- Complete: Master Promissory Note

EXCELSIOR SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

- NYS Resident
- U.S. Citizen or eligible Non- Citizen
- Complete the FAFSA and TAP application
- Not be in default of any federal student direct loan
- Agree to the State obligations
- Cannot already have an Associates or prior Bachelor degree

EXCELSIOR SCHOLARSHIP CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

 Have completed the equivalent of 30 credits per year (Fall; Winter; Spring; Summer)

No breaks in attendance

College will verify credit completion

 Student must be on-track for on-time degree completion

- > Some FAFSA's are selected for a process called verification to ensure the accuracy of information entered. During this process we will verify:
- The number of people in your (parent's household)
- Student's and parent's tax information
- Student's and parent's asset information
- If independent, student and spouse tax and asset information
- > Check your "To Do" List on CunyFirst and submit the necessary documentation to ensure timely processing of your financial aid.
