In individual, private consultation and under the supervision of NYS licensed clinical faculty, graduate students in Speech Language Pathology will assess speech and share their findings, specifying if there are aspects that may be interfering with clear, effective English language communication. These may include:

- accents and regionalisms
- poor articulation
- speech pathologies and communication disorders
