

## **The Sam Green Memorial Scholarship**

The Department of Radiologic Technology & Medical is pleased to announce another round of the **Sam Green Memorial Scholarship** for eligible students in the **clinical phase** of the program.

## Fall Semester Deadline: August 15; Spring Semester Deadline: January 15

<u>Purpose</u> – The purpose of this scholarship is to offer financial support to current radiologic technology and medical imaging students that are in their junior or senior year of the program.

<u>Scholarship Awards</u> – Distribution of awards for a given semester is determined based on the Scholarship Committee's evaluation of the validity and appropriate need of candidates. Over the past years, many students have been awarded partial or total sum of their semester tuition or other fees ranging from \$500 to \$3,000+.

<u>Use of Scholarships</u> – Scholarship awards may be applied toward tuition, fees, or other costs directly related to the associate radiologic technology and medical imaging program.

<u>Basis of Award</u> – The Scholarship Committee, comprised of radiologic technology and medical imaging personnel, will make the final selection of students to receive the scholarship based on their review of the candidate's personal statement, financial statement or Bursar invoice, academic qualifications/accomplishments and reasons for selecting the candidate for the scholarship.

The committee requests that the **personal statement** be no more than 2 pages long when printed. It has to clearly include at least one paragraph on financial need, one paragraph on academic qualifications, and one paragraph on career goals. Candidates may also include additional information on recent research projects, on-campus or off-campus activities and accomplishments, and educational plans that would assist the Committee in reaching a decision.

**NOTE:** Former Sam Green Memorial Scholarship recipients are eligible to reapply <u>each</u> semester providing they continue to meet the eligibility requirements.

**Financial need** may be documented by submitting a Bursar Invoice for unpaid tuition, or a Bursar Financial Statement or a record of Registration **Hold/Block** on the student's account for unpaid tuition balance.

Academic qualifications/accomplishments in the form of the candidate's most up-to-date City Tech student transcript must be submitted for evaluation.

## How To Apply

Attach separately to an email all documentations including:

- 1. The personal statement
- 2. Tuition invoice or financial statement from Bursar
- 3. City Tech student transcript (most up-to-date)

The subject on the email must indicate "The Sam Green Memorial Scholarship Spring 2025".
