1. Budget Allocation for Student Clubs

- Discussion: The budget committee proposed a \$700 allocation for each student club for Fall 2024, with a total club budget of \$55,299. Members discussed the suitability of this allocation.
- Motion: [Name] motioned to approve \$700 per club; [Name] seconded.
- Vote: 09
- In Favor: 8
- Opposed: 0
- Abstentions: 1
- Outcome: Motion passed; \$700 per club approved.

2. Approval of SGA Leadership Retreat Budget

- Discussion: The proposed \$47,200 retreat budget initially required 45% funding from SGA, 45% from student clubs, and 10% from CAB. Concerns were raised over using significant student funds for the retreat, suggesting alternatives.
- Motion: [Name] motioned to approve the \$21,240 allocation from SGA; [Name] seconded.
- Vote: 09
- In Favor :01
- Opposed: Majority opposed, motion failed.
- Alternative Motion: Revised funding with 35% from SGA and 10% from clubs.
- Motion: motioned to approve this revised allocation; seconded.
- Vote: 09
- In Favor: Majority
- Outcome: Motion passed with majority support.



3. Approval of New Student Government Officers

- Discussion: After interviews, the ad hoc committee presented several candidates for SGA positions, including Tamika Flores (Senior Professional Studies), Maureen O'Hare (Senior Technical and Design), and others.
- Motion: motioned to approve all candidates; seconded.
- Vote: 09
- In Favor: Unanimously approved
- Outcome: Motion passed; all candidates confirmed.

4. Certification of New Student Clubs

- The following clubs presented their missions, objectives, and plans for student benefits. After each presentation, motions were raised, and votes were conducted for certification.

 - Mission: Provide opportunities in data science through hackathons and projects.
