Make Sure to Check Off Each Task Below:

Make sure City Tech has received an official transcript from all colleges attended.

Official transcript must:

- be officially sealed
- include final semester grades
- provide graduation date, if applicable*
- * If unable to provide an official transcript with graduation date, a sealed letter from the Registrar will be sufficient
- Claim Account: If you have not claimed your CUNYfirst account go to http://home.cunyfirst.cuny.edu
 to do so. For instructions If you have any questions, visit the Student Help Desk located in L-114.
- Students who have attended a foreign high school are required to take the Ability to Benefit (ATB) test before January 27, 2020. Please call the Office of Academic Testing at 718-260-5171 to schedule an appointment.
- Students in need of reasonable accommodation should call The Center for Student Accessibility at 718.260.5143 for more information or to set up an intake appointment.
- Please check your CUNYfirst account to see if we have an immunization hold on your record.

 If so, you will need to provide proof of your immunization to the Transfer Student Center located in N-401. The immunization form can be downloaded at http://www.citytech.cuny.edu/admissions/immunization-requirements.aspx
- Submit the paperwork necessary to receive in-state tuition, if requested, to the Scholarships and Residency office located in N-401. The last day you can submit your proof for the Spring 2020 semester is May 22, 2020.
